

126TH STREET & FORD DRIVE ROUNDABOUT

Drive Fishers is the City of Fishers' initiative to increase travel efficiency, improve connectivity, and maintain the sanitary sewer and water infrastructure via innovative projects and a proactive approach to construction and maintenance.

Since 2012, Drive Fishers has completed traffic calming projects, sanitary and storm sewer projects, 200 resurfaced lane miles, 112 miles of trails and sidewalks, and received more than \$79 million in grants, improving the infrastructure in Fishers while leveraging federal dollars to save money for the Fishers' taxpayers.

Infrastructure improvement projects contribute to long-term vitality of our community and increased economic development opportunities. PROJECT SCOPE

The City of Fishers is building a roundabout at the intersection of 126th Street and Ford Drive. As part of the project, curb and gutter will substitute the shoulders and a storm sewer system will be constructed. Splitter islands will tie into the SR 37 project and trails on both sides of the intersection will be included. The project will be completed in two phases and is anticipated to reopen in October.

Phase 1 is currently underway with 126th Street closed beginning at the Nickel Plate Trail crossing to Ford Drive. Residents and businesses on and east of Ford/Windsor Drive will be accessible from southbound SR 37 only. View the official detour map [here](#).

During Phase 2, 126th Street will be closed east of Ford Drive to Kirkpatrick Way. Residents and businesses on Ford/Windsor Drive will be accessible from Lantern Road. Lockhart Cadillac will be accessible from southbound SR 37 only. View the official detour map [here](#).

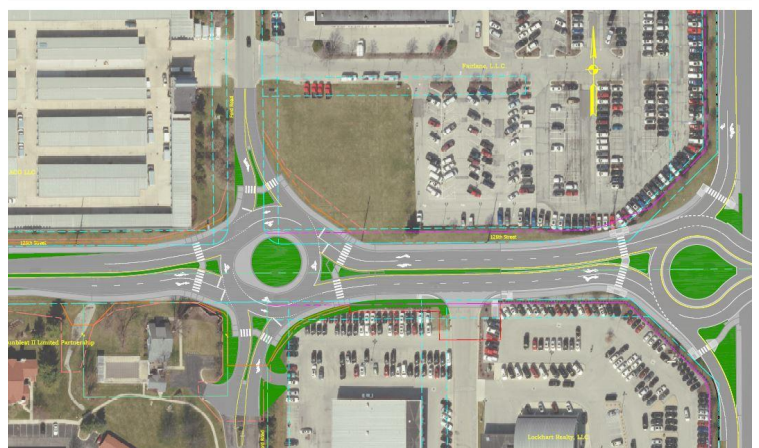
